Show what you know mindmap:

• KS1: Return to collaborative mindmap and discuss answer to question (teachers to photocopy for title page)

Socrative quizzes:

• KS2: Socrative quiz: Same as start of topic to show progress (Scores and reports distributed to Showbie)

Following half term and ongoing

Extended writing:

• KS2: Written piece to answer enquiry question

Dialogue and collaboration:


